- Pain and discomfort already here




Now change is low risk!

- More guerilla marketing


And this is why...

Big pictures are made of details

- Details should advance the big picture
- Audit them for long-term utility
- Don't waste time on unrelated ones
- Time is precious



Focus on the big picture!

More useful:

- "Who can use the software now if we implement this?"
- "Is this API suitable for 3rd-party developers?"

Less useful:

- "Let's rename all the variables to have a consistent style!"
- "Should this 4 px margin be 6 px?"

Window of opportunity will close

- Eventually things get better
- People and institutions will become changeaverse again

Good for you


You'll be happier working on important stuff
