The main reasons we decided to collect funds are:

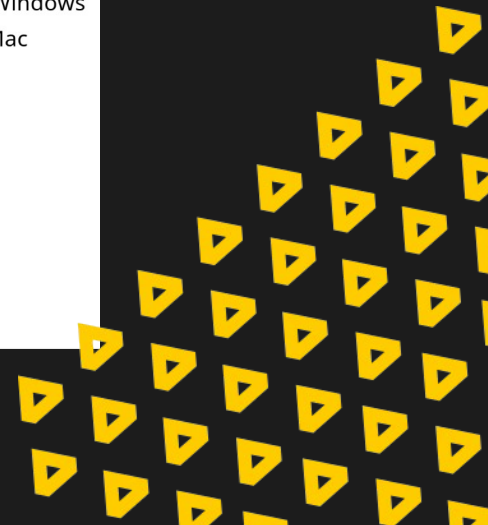
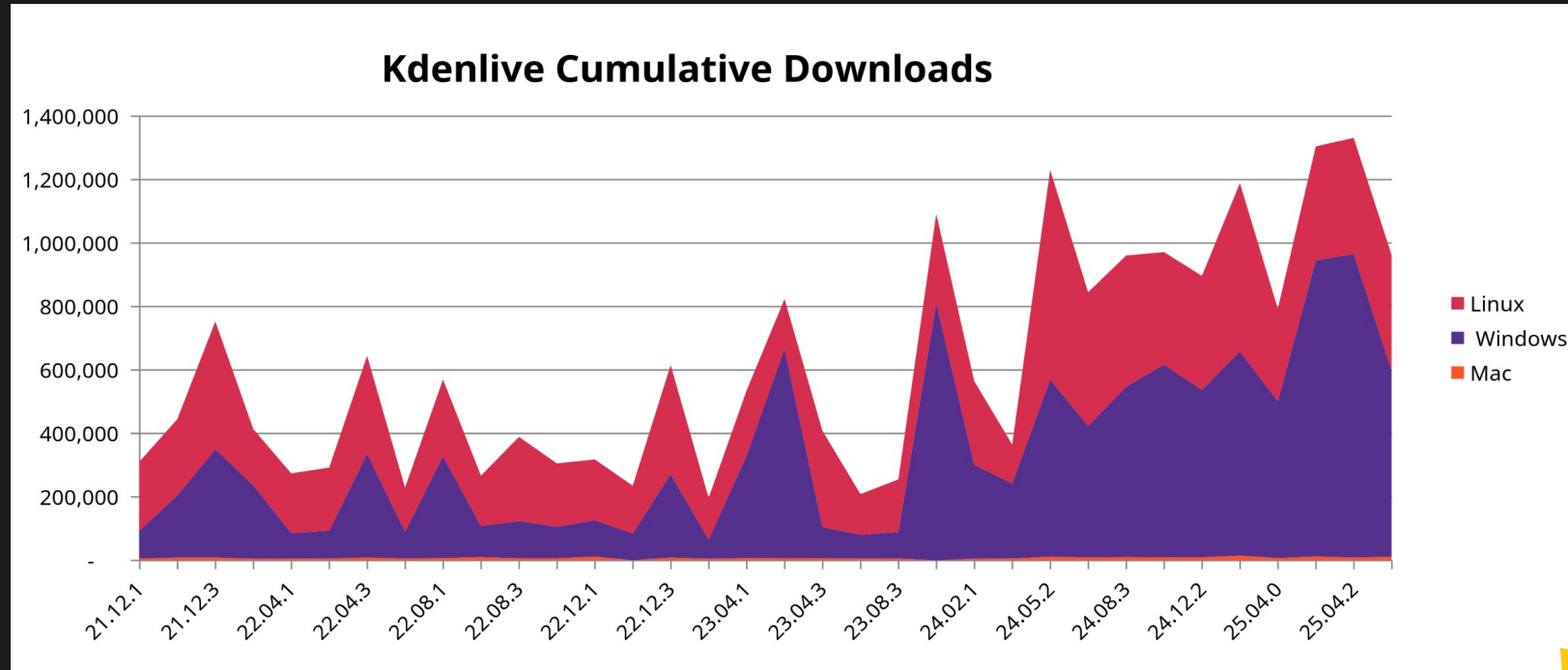
- A **healthier** life for the maintainer

Funds used since 2022

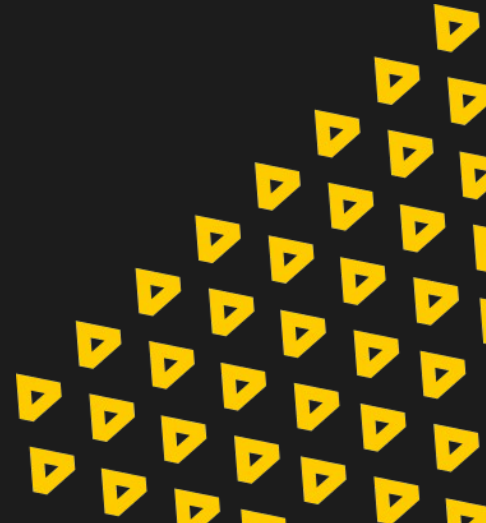


Working with external developers

- **Audio waveform** refactoring



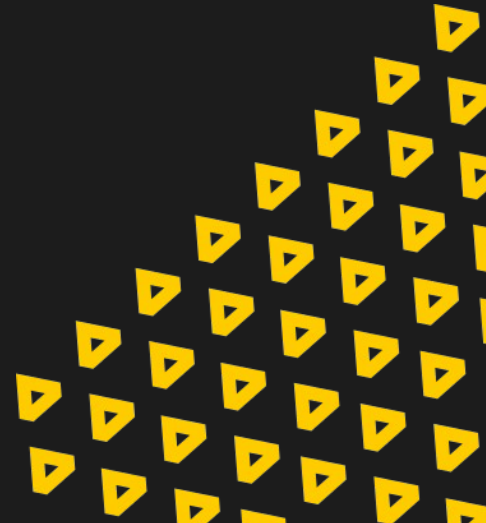


Our plan

- **Advertise** our product



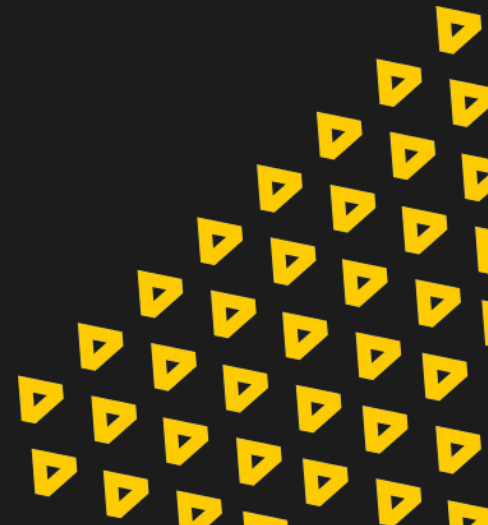


How to survive

- Identify and work on our **weaknesses**



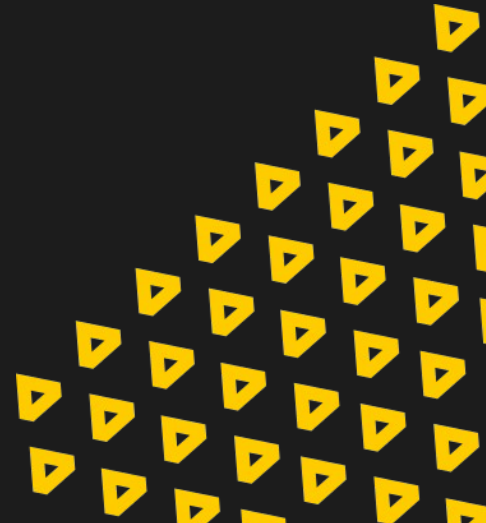

- Get in touch with **schools**



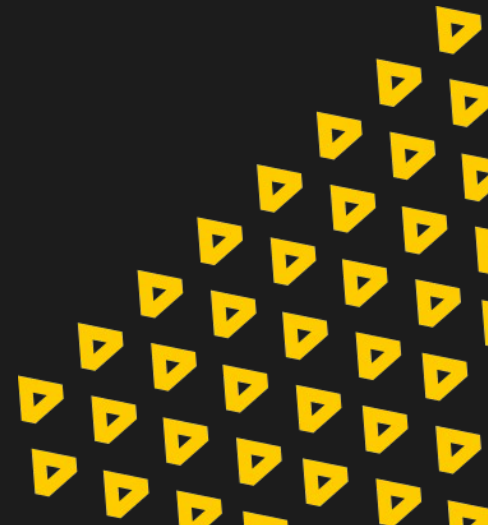


How to survive
